COMMISSIONER OF THE REVENUE
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PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION FOR DISABLED VETERANS

The provisions of the Code of Virginia, Title 58.2-3506 et. seq., and the code of the City of Williamsburg Sec. 18-30 allow for a personal property tax exemption for disabled veterans of the United States Armed Forces. The provision is as follows:

One motor vehicle owned and regularly used for personal transportation by any disabled veteran of the United States Armed Forces shall be exempt from personal property taxation. As used in this section, "disabled veteran" means any veteran of the United States Armed Forces who has either lost, or lost the use of, one or both legs, arms or hands, or who is blind, or who is permanently and totally disabled as certified by the Department of Veterans' Services.

To qualify for this exemption, you will need to provide the following documentation, along with this form:

- Photo identification
- Written statement from the Department of Veteran's Affairs that such veteran has been so designated or classified as to meet the requirements and that his/her disability is service connected.
