

**ARE YOU ABOUT TO BLOW IT AND NOT EVEN KNOW IT?**

STORM DRAINS are not TRASH CANS for FALL LEAVES.

Leaves CLOG storm drains which causes FLOODING.  
 And if not removed, ROTTING leaves cause ALGAE BLOOMS THAT HARM local fish and crab populations.

SO  RAKE 'EM  BAG 'EM  
 MULCH 'EM  COMPOST 'EM

However you get rid of fall leaves, make sure you KEEP THEM OUT OF THE STORM DRAIN.

**If you've been blowing those annoying leaves into the street and down the storm drain - you've blown it! Leaves should never be blown or raked into storm drains. When leaves enter storm drains, they clog the pipes and cause street flooding. And if they aren't removed, the leaves will start to decay, which sends a whole lot of nutrients into our waterways. Our local fish and crab populations can't thrive when nutrient-fueled algal bloom and choke the waterways. We know you want to do your part to protect our water.**

The City provides free curbside collection of leaves as a service to our residents. The following guidelines are provided to assist you in receiving the best service:

- There are 5 collections for each route during the months of November, December and first week of January.
- Please refer to the schedule for your route and corresponding collection dates.
- In order to progressively move from one route to the next, each street on each route will be collected only once during the week.
- Leaves must be raked to the street by 7:00 a.m. of the first day of the collection week. e.g. if your collection is the week of Nov. 15 - Nov. 19, leaves must be at the street by 7:00 a.m. on Nov. 15.
- Rake leaf piles to curbside or road edge, not in the street. or in drainage way (ditch, swales).
- Place leaf piles in an open area for easy vacuum truck access. Leaf piles behind vehicles, trees or bushes cannot be picked up.
- Do not mix sticks or limbs into your leaf piles.
- In case of rain, crews will pick up on the route where they left off prior to the rain.
- If you miss these collections or prefer to bag your leaves, place bagged leaves curbside on your regular garbage collection day. There is a 10 bag limit per household per collection day.



City crews will be collecting Christmas Trees on Tuesday, January 2 and Monday January 8. Trees must be placed at the street before 7:00 a.m. for collection. Please remove all decorations and lights.
